Barbering

1. Type of Programme

- Short Learning Programme (SLP)

Short programmes upgrade skills and knowledge to ensure success in a chosen field of learning, but are not credit bearing.

2. Description

The Short Programme in Barbering prepares the student to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of Cutting and Shaping gent's hair to achieve straight edge cut or a blended appearance using a clipper, scissor or straight edge razor.

The purpose of the Short Programme is to equip the student to work in the Hair Industry cutting gent's hair. With experience and additional qualifications obtained, there is the possibility of applying to board the cruise ships as a Barber.

3. Admission requirements

- Knowledge, comprehension and application of English language and Mathematical literacy at Grade 9 or equivalent.
- NQF Level 2
- Beneficial to have employment at a Hair Salon.
- Admission may be subject to an interview with an academic staff member.

4. Duration

The programme duration is 21 hours, including practical demonstrations. Practical training is face to face. Dermatech tuition/ workshops are scheduled at specific times of the year. Programmes are offered during week days. The programme requires learners to have live models to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of performing barbering services to be completed within practical training. After attendance of the workshop, certification of attendance will take place.

5. Textbooks and study material

All prescribed material is included. A list of student material and textbooks if necessary will be provided by Dermatech campus academic department.

6. Pricing

7. Additional costs

Due to the nature of the hairdressing industry, existing hairdressers might have their own kit available, therefore hair kits are priced separately to the training. Students must make provision for kit items such as a fader brush, shaving bowl and shaving brush (full kit list available upon request).

The following topics are covered in this Short Programme:

- Practical
 - Identifying possible risks associated with cutting while using a clipper, scissor and straight edge razor
 - Resolving risks through knowledge and technique
 - Correct use and care of tools
 - The art of blending with a clipper and a scissor
 - Finishing with a clipper
 - Finishing with a scissor
 - Balloon training
 - Preparing the towel and skin for shaving
 - Shaving and shaping with a razor
 - Caring for the skin after shaving
 - Facial massage techniques for barbers

9. Career fields

With this programme, successful students could pursue a career as a barber.

10. Certification

On successful completion of the short programme, the student will receive a Dermatech Certificate of attendance in Barbering.
