1. Type of Programme

- Short Learning Programme (SLP)

2. Description

The Short Programme in Eyebrow Shaping and Lash & Brow Tinting provides the student with the knowledge and skills to apply, and remove tint and shape the eyebrows.

The purpose of the Short Programme is to equip the student to work in the Health and Skincare industry as a professional lash and brow tinting and shaping therapist. It is an ideal short programme to add on for manual facial therapists, nail technicians, hairdressers and make-up artists. It will upgrade the skill of a therapist that works in a Salon or Spa environment.

3. Admission requirements

- Knowledge, comprehension and application of English language and Mathematical literacy at Grade 10 or equivalent.
- Admission may be subject to an interview with an academic staff member.

4. Duration

The programme duration is 20 total hours, including practical, theory and case studies. Theory is completed in a self-study manner, while practical training is face to face and case studies are completed in a private capacity. Dermatech tuition is scheduled at specific times of the year. Programmes are offered during week days. Case studies need to be completed within 2 months from practical training completion. After successful completion of the case studies and assessment, certification will take place.
