### 1. Type of Programme

- Short Learning Programme (SLP)

Short programmes upgrade skills and knowledge to ensure success in a chosen field of learning, but are not credit bearing.

### 2. Description

The Short Programme in Microblading provides the student with the knowledge and skills to design, apply and maintain the semi-permanent cosmetic tattoo procedure.

The purpose of the Short Programme is to equip the student to work in the Health and Skincare industry as a professional Microblading Technician. It will upgrade the skill of an individual that works in a Salon or Spa environment. This is a very unique proficiency that is growing and very in demand. Microblading provides a great opportunity to create one's own business.

### 3. Admission requirements

- Knowledge, comprehension and application of English language and Mathematical literacy at Grade 12 or equivalent.
- Brow Shaping and Lash & Brow Tinting SLP or equivalent
- Admission may be subject to an interview with an academic staff member.

### 4. Duration

The programme duration is 40 total hours, including practical, theory and case studies. Theory is completed in a self-study manner, while practical training is face to face and case studies are completed in a private capacity. Dermatech tuition is scheduled at specific times of the year. Programmes are offered during week days. Case studies need to be completed within 2 months from practical training completion. After successful completion of an assessment and case studies, certification will take place.
